THE CHALLENGE

The BILK Kombiterminal Co. Plc. was opened on November 17, 2003. The company contracted with Konecranes in order to get cranes that would meet customer requirements and provide suitable performance during the operation.

THE SOLUTION

BILK Kombiterminal ordered two container gantry cranes for the new Intermodal terminal south of Budapest. The cranes had a lifting capacity of 42 t (the loads are 20-45 feet containers.) The cranes have been working 24 hours per day, seven days a week since 2003.

THE RESULTS

The most relevant factors that led to receiving the order were Konecranes' technical know-how, extensive maintenance network in Hungary and previous deliveries of similar container cranes.

The annual volume of the terminal grew from 55,000 containers in 2004 to 90,000 containers in 2008.

Two service contracts also were signed with Konecranes' Hungarian subsidiary Konecranes Kft.:

- A maintenance contract including bi-weekly crane repairs (during the weekend)
- An inspection contract including monthly structural inspections (two times per year)
